# POSTER & ORAL PRESENTERS

- Each student should prepare a 10 minute <u>pre-recorded</u> presentation using Powerpoint for oral presentations or a research poster for poster presentations.
- All students participating in poster presentations should also submit a separate pdf document of their poster with the video.
- All presentations should be uploaded to YouTube.

# CHANGES TO POSTER & ORAL PRESENTERS

- No judging will occur on-site.
- Judging will be completed before the conference begins.
- Although, oral and poster presentations will be submitted early in the form of a recording, <u>all</u> <u>students will be expected to present at the Saeopp McNair/SSS Research Conference in person.</u>

## ORAL PRESENTERS

- Students need to be at their assigned room locations and begin their presentations promptly as scheduled.
- If you are not in your room at your designated time, you WILL NOT be able to present!
- Students will have 10 minutes to present their research.
- Students will also have two minutes for a question and answer segment.

# POSTER PRESENTERS

- Students need to be at the poster designated room for the entire duration of the poster session.
- Students must stand next to their posters for the entire session.
- Posters should be no larger than 36 x 48.
- A time for poster set-up will be announced at the conference.

## POSTER & ORAL PRESENTERS

 It is imperative that students access their email consistently from June 10, 2023 until June 21, 2023 in case the judges or the research team have questions about your research project.

## REMINDERS FOR ALL POSTER & ORAL PRESENTERS

#### **Requirements:**

- All abstracts should be submitted by June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023 by 11:59 p.m.
- The deadline to upload pre-recorded poster and or oral presentations is June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- Students should only submit one pre-recorded research project. Students can not compete in both oral and poster presentations. Students cannot compete twice in oral and twice in poster presentations. Students also cannot compete individually and then with a group.

## CATEGORIES

- The oral & poster sessions are divided into seven categories:
- Humanities
- Life Science
- Physical Science
- Social Science
- Education
- Health
- Business
- Each category will have a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner.
- The poster is a separate category and there will also be a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner.

# PRESENTATIONS WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING:

- Statement/Identification of Research Problem
- Research design, procedures (materials & methods)
- Intellectual Honesty and Appropriate Attributions
- Discussion/Conclusion
- Presentation Effort & Performance
- Presentation- Demonstrates Skill in Communicating Research Results
